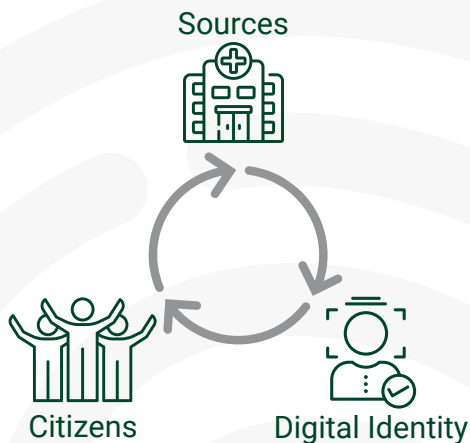

IDINA

IDINA is developing a platform to ensure access to identity registration for all citizens in an effective and inclusive way in regions with insufficient or no civil registration infrastructure.

How will IDINA help?



In this approach, local entities, responsible for events such as vaccination or entry into education, use the IDINA solution to certify identification data about the citizens with whom they interact on a daily basis. IDINA consolidates and estimates the quality of the information collected and citizens, in turn, use the non-authoritative identity produced by IDINA to exercise citizenship.

Goals

Guarantee security and access to essential services for all citizens.

Decrease the number of people without identification, helping to build an increasingly fair and egalitarian society.

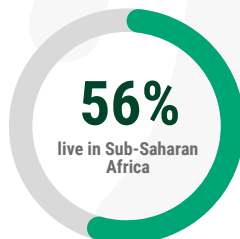
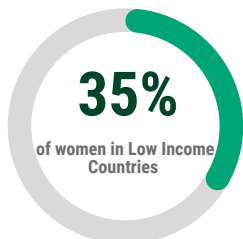
